4:45 – 5:30pm	Team-Building/Arts & Crafts/Physical Activities/Clubs
5:30 – 6:00pm	Free Time

Location: Students are picked up from school by a MAP staff and walked to the Irving Park Lutheran Church gym, 4057 N. Harding Ave.

Cost: \$25 registration fee for 1 child or \$35 per family

Tuition Tier	How to Determine Your Tuition Level Based on Household Income
\$40/week per child	Gross household income \$50,000 or less <i>*Proof of income required for this tier</i>
\$60/week per child	Gross household income between \$51,000 - \$89,999 <i>*Proof of income required.</i>
\$90/week per child	Gross household income \$90,000 or more
